TIEC University Fair Assists Students

Representatives from public universities in Texas travelled to TIEP in September to provide information about their admissions procedures to TIEP students.



TIEP staff arrange university fairs twice a year to assist students in learning more about the American university system and to help them make the transition from TIEP to a bachelor's, master's or doctoral program.

TIEP has [conditional admission arrangements](#) with 17

universities and colleges in Texas. Conditional admission provides a student assured admission to a participating university once he or she meets English-language or other specific requirements that the university may set.

TIEP has [TOEFL waiver arrangements](#) with 19 universities and colleges in Texas. These 19 institutions agree to waive the TOEFL score requirements for TIEP's advanced-level students who have successfully completed TIEP's English for Academic Purposes Program and who are seeking admission to their campuses.

TIEP Provides English Instruction at New Location

The Texas Intensive English Program began providing administrative and instructional services for the Lamar Language Institute at Lamar University in Beaumont this semester.

The Lamar Language Institute now has 30 full-time

students in three levels of English instruction, with an additional 40 Lamar University students taking part-time English courses in reading, writing, and speaking.

TIEP administrators have visited Lamar University

several times since August to implement the new program, and Institute instructors travelled to Austin in October to meet TIEC headquarters staff and become more familiar with TIEP's Austin-based program.
