### Battle Reenactments at Camp Mabry

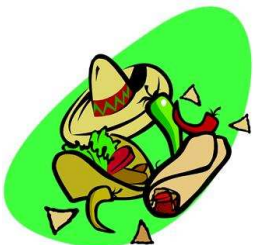
Reenactments of the Battle of Puebla
